CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CHILDREN

American Football Development Limited is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all attendees of its clinics and camps. American Football Development Limited believes that it is important that all individuals associated or employed by the company should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, attendees are encouraged to be open at all times and to share concerns with complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with American Football Development's Welfare and Safeguarding Officers.

Sports camps should offer a positive experience for young people where they can learn new things in a safe and positive environment. As an attendee of American Football Development Limited's camps and clinics, you are expected to abide by the following junior code of practice:

- Be loyal and give your friends a second chance
- Be friendly to all attendees
- Be supportive and committed to other attendees, offer comfort when required
- Keep yourself safe
- Report inappropriate behaviour or risky situations for youth members
- Play fairly and be trustworthy
- Respect camp staff and counsellors, and accept decisions
- Behave and listen to all instructions from the coach
- Take care of equipment owned or provided by American Football Development Limited and its partners
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background or religious beliefs or sexual identity
- Refrain from the use of bad language or racial/sectarian references
- Do not get involved in inappropriate peer pressure and push others into something they do not want to do
- Refrain from bullying or persistent use of rough and dangerous play
- Keep to agreed timings for all camp activities, or inform a member of the camp's staff if you are going to be late
- Wear suitable kit
- Do not smoke on camp premises
- Do not consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on camp premises

You have the right to:

- Be safe and happy while at an American Football Development Limited Camp
- Be listened to
- Be respected and treated fairly
- Privacy
- Enjoy the camp activities in a protective environment
- Be referred to professional help if needed
- Be protected from abuse by other attendees or outside sources
- Participate on an equal basis, appropriate to your ability
- Be believed
- Ask for help
